Appellation / Plot Description

Chambolle takes its name from the bubbling appearance of the “Grône” stream. In 1878 the name of its best cru, “Musigny”, was appended to the village name. This A.O.C. is for red wine only and covers a total area of 182 hectares.

This plot is located above *Amoureuses* next to *Musigny*. It is one of Premiers Crus and has an area of just 1 hectares 42 ares. The vines are planted on almost the rock. The soil composition is precisely the same as the northern part of Musigny.



Vinification / Ageing

- Manual picking
- Strong selection of the grapes in the vineyard and at the winery
- 100% de-stemming, no crushing.
- Gravity feeding of the tanks.
- Cold pre-fermentation maceration, indigenous yeasts.
- Treading of the cap
- Ageing in French oak casks from Allier forest.
