2013 TURBINE WHITE, SONOMA VALLEY

VINEYARD NOTES

The fruit for our Turbine White was sourced from two family-owned vineyards. Marsanne and Roussanne are grown at Landa Vineyard located in the shadows of the eastern foothills in the Sonoma Valley Appellation. The Roussanne adds floral aromatics while the Marsanne is a beautiful blending wine adding nice mid-palate richness to the wine along with acidity. Grenache Blanc and Picpoul Blanc are grown nearby at the Snow Vineyard. Grenache Blanc lends long length and balanced alcohol to the blend, along with rich notes of citrus and herbs. Picpoul Blanc, which translates to "lip stinger," is a great complement to these other Rhône-style varietals bringing a tropical lushness combined with crisp, mineral acids and spiciness.

TASTING NOTES

Named for the iconic image of the wind turbine on our label, our Turbine White is a delicious blend of white Rhone-style varietals. Light citrus blossom aromas mingle with stone fruit, lychee and herbal notes. The overall bouquet is light, but the flavor profile is full. The palate is initially bright with flavors of tropical fruits and orange oil giving way to a richer mid-palate and slightly nutty characteristics.

TECHNICAL NOTES

Varietals: 42% Roussanne, 20% Grenache Blanc, 20% Picpoul Blanc, 18% Marsanne

Appellation: Sonoma Valley

Vineyards: Landa Vineyard, Snow Vineyard

Harvest: 9/29 & 10/7

Alcohol: 14.0

Method: Hand-harvested, whole cluster pressed, native yeast, 50% barrel and 50% stainless fermentation. 10 weeks batonnage, sur lees.

Aging: 8 months in French Oak barrels, 30% new

Cases produced: 354
