Characteristics of the Sauvignon

- White grape
- 30 % of production
- Production 50-60 hectolitres / hectare
- Wine produced at a low temperature, 16–18 °C.
- Bottling : 6 months after harvest.

The taste of a Sauvignon

Always a dry wine the Sauvignon has a powerful fragrance, a harmony of all the riches of the land with a delicate hint of muscatel. Connoisseurs will recognise the distinctive “gunflint” taste..

The wine waiter recommends

- To be drunk within 2 years
- Serve at a temperature of 8 – 10 °C

To accompany :

- Shellfish.
- Grilled or fried fish.
- Snails, asparagus.
