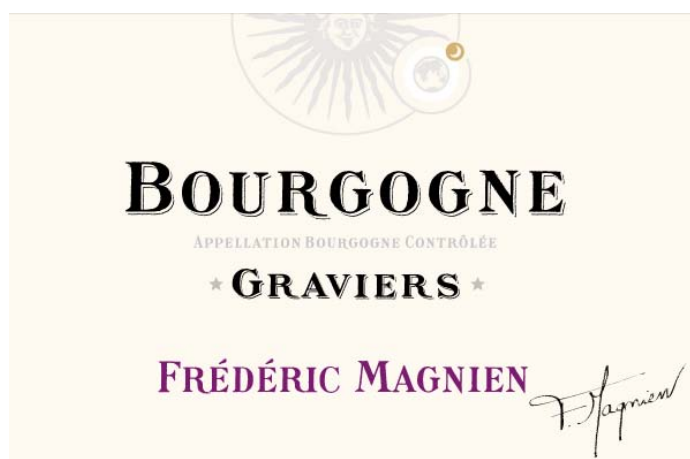




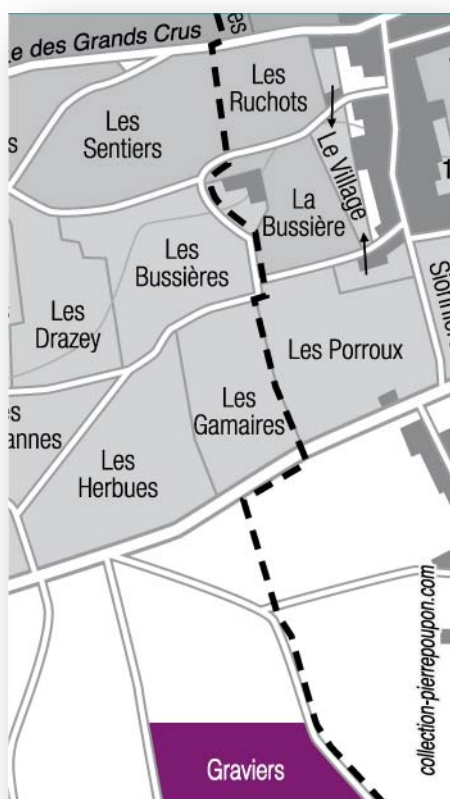

Appellation / Plot Description

It is in 1395 that Philippe Le Hardi forbade the cultivation of Gamay in favor of Pinot Black to improve wine quality. Within the Bourgogne AOC are produced red wines, white and rosé. The regional appellation covers nearly 2500 hectares of the Yonne department to the Côte-d'Or.



Vinification / Ageing

- Manual picking
- Strong selection of the grapes in the vineyard and at the winery
- 100% de-stemming, no crushing.
- Gravity feeding of the tanks.
- Cold pre-fermentation maceration, indigenous yeasts.
- Treading of the cap
- Ageing in French oak casks from Allier forest.
