 PASO ROBLES CALIFORNIA

BACKGROUND

In folklore dating back to pre-biblical times, the Mandrake root has been imbued with all manner of magical powers. It was known to be an antidote enchantments, to make the barren fertile and, most commonly, to have power as a love potion. Aphrodite, Greek goddess of Love, was sometimes known as 'Lady of the Mandrake' due to the use of the root as an aphrodisiac. This elixir, made from 100% Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon, will seduce and entice with its amazing texture and undeniable ancestry. Aphrodite would drink this wine.

ELEVAGE & TASTING NOTES

Made from fruit grown in a single vineyard in the heart of the Paso Robles Highlands AVA, this wine was aged for 12 months in small French oak barrels, including 20% second-use barrels. It was handled gently, with only a single racking before bottling.

The wine is dark with a deep aromatic bouquet of cherry, cassis and sandalwood. The palate is rich and delicious with notes of blackberry, plum, cigar box and cloves.

This wine was bottled unfiltered and aged in the cellar for six months before release. Producing it during the tumultuous year of 2020 reminds us that the vines keep growing and wine helps us stay connected even when we are apart. The acidity in this wine will keep it lively for years, but it's tasting great now, so why wait?
