Vineyard Notes:

Alicante Bouschet is Sonoma Valley's dark house varietal. Not surprisingly the grape is found in every old-vine field blended vineyard across the state of California. It is classically identified by its red pulp, large clusters, oval shaped berries, and vibrantly red foliage. Our Alicante is a perfect blend between Liquid Amber Vineyard and Bedrock Vineyard

Vinification:

50% whole cluster. Fermented with ambient yeast in a combination of stainless steel open top fermenters and 1 ton T-Bins. Pressed at dryness & left to age in neutral French oak barrels and California Amphora.
