The cuttings are of a clone originally selected in Beaujolais with vines growing more upright than Pinot Noir and with paler leaves, larger grapes and tighter clusters. Concentrated purple colored grapes are more resistant to botrytis and thrive in a warmer climate in The Shop Vineyard. The soils are clay loam - a good fit for the high acid and late ripening Gamay.
