Varietal: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot, 1% Cab Franc

Port of Call: Napa Valley

Vessel: Fermented in stainless steel tank.

Aged 18 months 85% French Oak (15% new) - 15% American Oak (new)

Winemaker: Brian Mox

On board: 3900 cases



Logbook: Fresh nose of cherry, blackberry, subtle raspberry and notes of oak and vanilla. Flavors of ripe cherry, red berry and fresh plum mingled with mocha. The palate is medium bodied with a sweet red fruit with nice balanced acidity and supple tannins.

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
