Cascina Guido Berta is ideally situated in the midst of the "Golden Triangle," well known for its fabulous Barbera wines.

In 1997, at the age of 25, Guido Berta decided to follow in the footsteps of his father and returned to the family farm with high ambitions for his wines. Guido grew up in an agricultural environment and after working for several years at other wineries, decided he was prepared to take over the family estate.

He started his activity by producing Barbera d'Asti – these days, his property is composed of 10 hectares dedicated to vines. Six hectares are planted with Barbera d'Asti vines; the remaining three hectares are planted with Moscato d'Asti and Chardonnay.
