



# 2019 Ürziger Würzgarten Auslese\*\*\*

**Winery:** Joh. Jos. Christoffel Erben

**Region:** Mosel, Germany

**Variety:** Riesling

**Flavour:** Noble-sweet

**Winemaker:** Philippe Conzen

**Vintage:** 2019, hand harvested in the third week of October

**Site:** Ürziger Würzgarten, Kranklay, 100 year-old-vines, original rootstocks, red slate soil

**Philippe's notes:** Hand-picked, 10% botrytis, immediate pressing, fermented with indigenous yeast under cool conditions, stopped at 98 g/L of residual sugar. Bottled in March 2020.

**Bottles made:** 2,600

**Tasting Notes:** Spices, citrus, pepper, dried porcini mushroom on the nose. The palate is at first creamy and deeply sweet, presenting a brown honey and raisin like taste. After 5 seconds in the mouth, a citrusy acidity kicks in which refreshes and balances the sweet feel.

**Analytcs:** 8,5% Vol Alcohol - 98.0g/L RS - 8.6g/L Acidity

**Pairing suggestions:** Cheese plates, salty-sweet desserts, Meditation wine
