

2020 Ürzig Würzgarten Kabinett

Region: Mosel, Germany

Variety: Riesling

Site: Ürziger Würzgarten, Maxberg, just above the graveyard of the village, steep vineyard with volcanic red soil and red slate, 80-year-old un-grafted vines.

Philippe's notes: healthy green Riesling grapes picked by hand in the first week of October, immediate pressing, must fermented with indigenous yeast down to 48g/L, bottled in April 2021

Bottles made: 10,600

Tasting Notes: Aromas of yellow pear, grapefruit paired with subtle herbal characteristics. A well-integrated acidity with mineral grip makes this wine feel not sweet nor dry on the palate. This is Kabinett. A balanced wine with incredible tension and flow.

Analytics: 8.5% Vol Alcohol - 47,8g/L RS - 8.4g/L Acidity
