



2021 Ürziger Würzgarten Spätlese

Winery: Joh. Jos. Christoffel Erben

Region: Mosel, Germany

Variety: Riesling

Flavour: Fruity-sweet

Winemaker: Philippe Conzen

Vintage: 2021, hand harvested in the third week of October

Site: Ürziger Würzgarten, Im Würzgarten, 100 year-old-vines, original rootstocks, red slate soil

Philippe's notes: Hand-picked, immediate pressing, fermented with indigenous yeast under cool conditions, stopped at 63 g/L of residual sugar. Bottled in December 2022.

Bottles made: 8,000

Tasting Notes: Delicate scents of white pepper, cardamom, and fine herbs accompanied by red citrus zest. The wine feels fresh and lively on the palate with a limey acidity that lingers and balances the gentle sweetness.
