



2022 Ürziger Würzgarten trocken

Winery: Joh. Jos. Christoffel Erben

Region: Mosel, Germany

Variety: Riesling

Flavour: Dry

Winemaker: Philippe Conzen

Vintage: 2022, a hot and dry year that put forward charming Riesling wines with a mild acidity

Site: Lower parts of the Ürziger Würzgarten, foothills of the vineyard with humus rich soil, average vine age 80 years

Philippe's notes: hand-picked in the second week of October, immediate pressing, 50% of must fermented with indigenous yeast under cool conditions, 50% fermented with selective yeast, 4 months on the fine lees, bottled in April 2023

Bottles made: 4,000

Tasting Notes: Aromas of yellow pear, grapefruit zest and a hint of smoked coconut. The wine is driven by melon and pear on the almost powerful palate, has a round, and pleasantly bitter finish. A perfect introduction to the legendary Würzgarten vineyard.

Analytics: 12.0% Vol Alcohol - 7.3g/L RS - 6.8g/L Acidity
