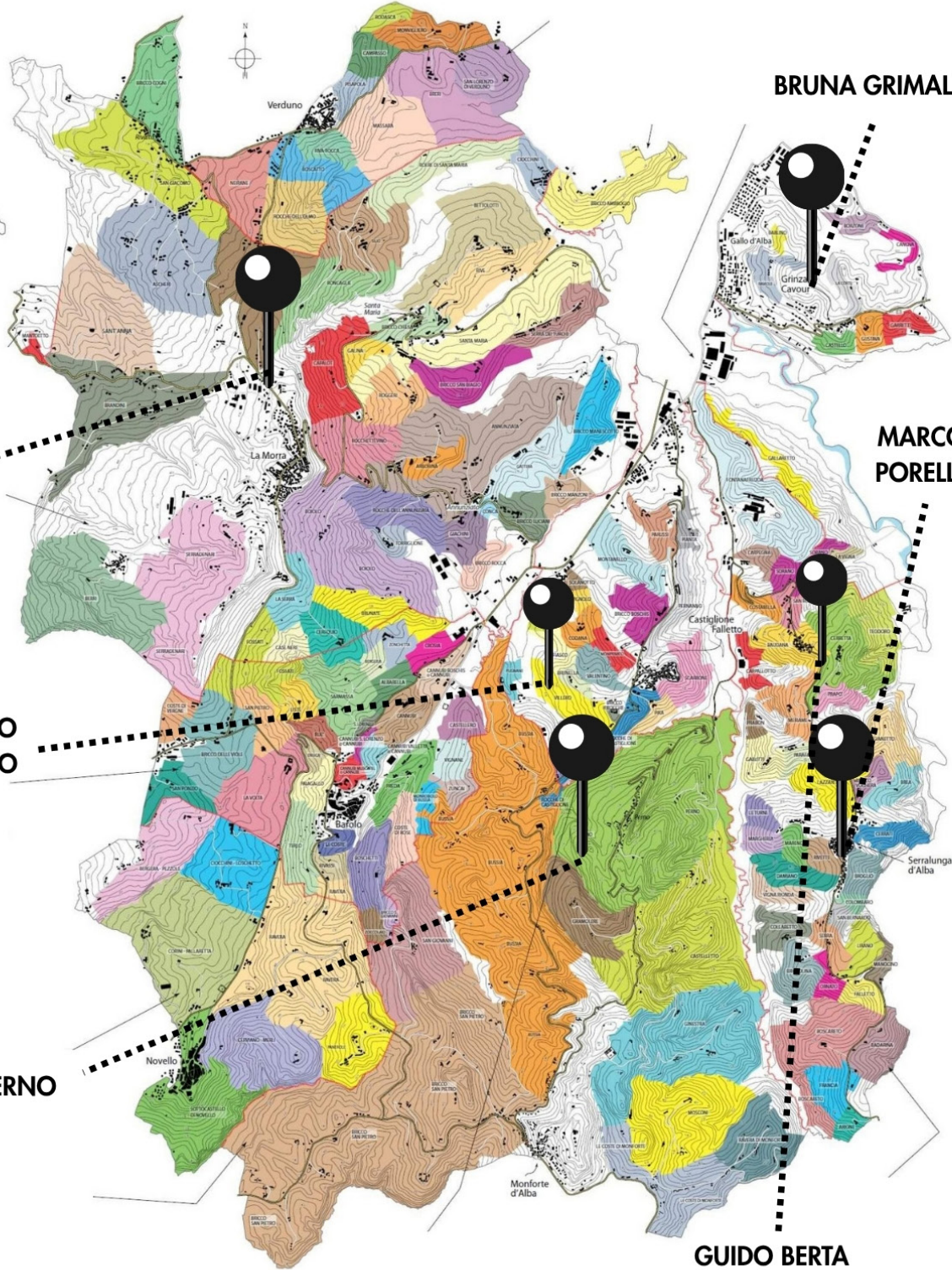

ALDO CONTERNO | ORGANIC

The story of Poderi Aldo Conterno, one of the elite, historic Barolo producers, is a tale of great passion for winemaking that winds back across generations and crosses international borders. Today the company is run by three sons of Aldo: Franco, Stefano, and Giacomo, who followed in the footsteps of their father and carry on the family tradition.

The "Poderi Aldo Conterno" winery is situated in Bussia of Monforte d'Alba which is the heart of the Barolo wine area. The estate, which vinifies exclusively its own grapes, consists of 25 hectares of vineyard. Most of the soil is at an altitude of 350-400 m. above the sea level, is located south/southwest, and is composed of clayey marls and limestone with layers of sand. The yields per hectare are very low and the total production is about 80,000 bottles a year. The harvest begins in mid-September and is done exclusively by hand with a very careful selection of the picked grapes. Always following a strict family tradition, wines are neither clarified nor filtered. These are clean, polished and ethereal wines of great elegance that are guaranteed to offer years of sublime drinking while being terrific collector's items.

BRUNA GRIMALDI

BRUNA GRIMALDI | ORGANIC & CERTIFIED SUSTAINABLE

The story of Azienda Bruna Grimaldi is one of family tradition: people born and raised in Barolo among the hills that connect the villages of Grinzane Cavour to Serralunga, combined with a passion for wine and working the vineyards that has been handed down through the decades. The winery has grown over the years, thanks to its dedication to the great wines of the Langhe and great care in the selection of the most suitable vineyards for the production of Barolo.

The philosophy of Bruna Grimaldi is simple and relies on basic principles: the quality of a wine originates in the vineyard and is largely determined through a good green harvest. Thanks to an attentive selection of grapes, they bottle impeccable wines that faithfully represent their region. The combined knowledge of Bruna Grimaldi and Franco Fiorino, along with the contribution of accomplished agronomist Giampiero Romana, have a sole aim: to cultivate the vines in such a way as to produce important, full-bodied wines with intense aromas, which highlight the best that nature and the soil have to offer. Ten hectares produce approximately 50,000 bottles that all express the typical essence of Langa wines, from Barolo to Dolcetto, from Barbera to Nebbiolo d'Alba. The identity of the winery, Bruna Grimaldi, is clear and defined, especially through its three cru Baroli: Barolo Badarina from Serralunga, Barolo Camilla from Grinzane Cavour and Barolo Bricco Ambrogio from Roddi. The work in the vineyards is performed following traditional methods: the vines develop naturally. The spontaneous growth of weeds is kept under control through mechanical means and not by the use of any herbicides. When the grapes start to ripen, they carry out analyses on sugar content, acidity and polyphenols, in order to harvest healthy grapes at the correct ripening level, which will give a wine with distinct aromas. No chemical products are used to control grey mold or pests, nor are any systemic products. The health of the grapes is guaranteed especially by the careful selections of bunches and leaves by hand, thus ensuring the production of grapes that give rise to quality wines.

MARCO PORELLO | SUSTAINABLE

Porello's inception reaches back to the 1930's, when Roero was not yet known for its great oenological successes in Arneis production. During this time Cesare Porello transformed his small property into a proper establishment dedicated to the production of wine in addition to peaches, a fruit for which the area of Canale was then famous and a flavor profile that is found in Porello Arneis to this day. From 1994 until today, the company has been run by Marco, Cesare's grandson and expert oenologist. Educated first at the Alba oenological school and then in the field both in the Bordeaux region of France as well as in Chianti Classico, Marco brings to the winery his institutional knowledge as well as an extended vision of the marriage of tradition and innovation in his winemaking. With over 50% of plantings being Arneis, Marco Porello is now known internationally for being a leading producer of excellent Arneis.

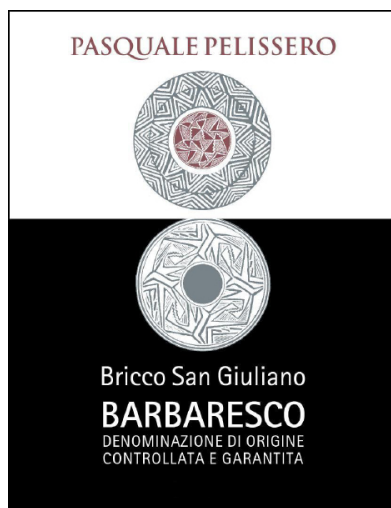

PASQUALE PELISSERO
Wine Passion in Neive

PASQUALE PELISSERO

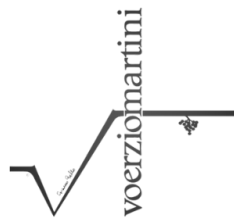
Pasquale Pelissero is a tiny, family-owned winery started in a garage by Pasquale Pelissero, one of the first producers in Neive to bottle and sell his own wines, known for their purity of expressing the Barbaresco terroir and traditional winemaking. Since the death of Pasquale in 2007, daughter Ornella has carried on the family tradition, doing everything on her own in the vineyards and cellar. Cantina Pasquale Pelissero sits close to the top of the Bricco San Giuliano hill, completely surrounded by vineyards. The Bricco San Giuliano Cru is an 8-hectare parcel at 400 meters above sea level and Ornella produces two Cru Barbaresco wines from this piece of land: 1) Bricco San Giuliano, made from 25-year old vines in the Cru and aged for 2 years, 90% in botti and 10% in French barrels and 2) Cascina Crosa, named after the Pelissero farm, made from 40-year old vines and aged for two years in 100% botte. One of the most historical and beautiful places in Neive, the winery's annual production is only around 15,000 bottles. The estate is a member of a consortium of Langhe producers called "Biotipicità," founded by producers who all adhere to the "lotta integrata," an Italian regulation governing sustainable farming methods.

VOERZIO MARTINI

Piedmont, and the Langhe, are lands of great wines: it is in this place, surrounded by a landscape of extraordinary beauty, that the winery Voerzio Martini is located. A newly imagined company with a long history, twins Mirko and Federica Martini took over the winery a decade ago, carrying on the traditions of the historic cellar Gianni Voerzio in La Morra. Gianni's successful and extensive experience as a wine producer is now supported by the innovative ideas of these next generation of Martini siblings.

The main mission of Voerzio Martini is the careful management of the vineyards, with the greatest respect for the surrounding environment as well as to achieve the highest quality of raw materials in grapes. The estate vineyards are both cherished historic vineyards of the winery, such as La Serra, and new vineyard acquisitions in prestigious Crus such as Cerequio and Monvigliero. In the cellar, Mirko uses a blend of new French oak and Slovenian botti to find the truest expression of their beloved Barolo terroir.

AZIENDA AGRICOLA BIOLOGICA

GIORDANO LOMBARDO | BIODYNAMIC

Nestled just outside the medieval village of Gavi among verdant woods and picturesque vineyards, the 20 hectares that make up the biodynamic vineyard of Giordano Lombardo straddle the border of the Piedmont and Liguria regions. The indigenous Cortese vines that are grown here give rise to an unadulterated wine that fully embodies the climate, soil and winemaking tradition of the region. Passionately committed to the idea that nature is a resource to be nurtured rather than exploited and misused, yields are kept low and the use of pesticides, herbicides, anti-mildew agents and fertilizers is strictly forbidden. After the grapes are hand-selected, they are brought to the temperature-controlled cellar where both vinification (both in barrels and bottles) and fining take place at a consistent temperature of 14/16 °C year-round. What results is a wine that bears the intense fragrances and characteristic flavors of the Gavi terroir.

GUIDO BERTA | CERTIFIED SUSTAINABLE

Cascina Guido Berta is ideally situated in the midst of the “Golden Triangle,” well known for its fabulous Barbera wines. In 1997, at the age of 25, Guido Berta decided to follow in the footsteps of his father and returned to the family farm with high ambitions for his wines. Guido grew up in an agricultural environment and after working for several years at other wineries, decided he was prepared to take over the family estate. He started his activity by producing Barbera d’Asti – these days, his property is composed of 10 hectares dedicated to vines. Six hectares are planted with Barbera d’Asti vines; the remaining three hectares are planted with Moscato d’Asti and Chardonnay.

DISTILLERIA FONDATA NEL 1885

MONTANARO

Founded in 1885, Francesco Trussoni, a master distiller from Gallo d'Alba, began the story of the Montanaro when he created the first single-grape grappa—Grappa di Barolo. In 1922, the distillery was taken over by Mario Montanaro, his wife Angela Trussoni, and their son Giuseppe. With this new generation came rigorous attention to detail including the innovative introduction of steam distillation, providing a slow, linear process for optimal control in flavor extraction rarely seen in Italy at the time. By 2000, Giuseppe Montanaro, now eighty and without direct heirs, decided to sell Montanaro Distillery to a group of Piedmontese business people from the agriculture, wine, and spirits fields. Today, thanks to its carefully stewarded growth and commitment to traditional distillation methods, the Montanaro Distillery places itself among the top players in the world of fine Italian spirits.
