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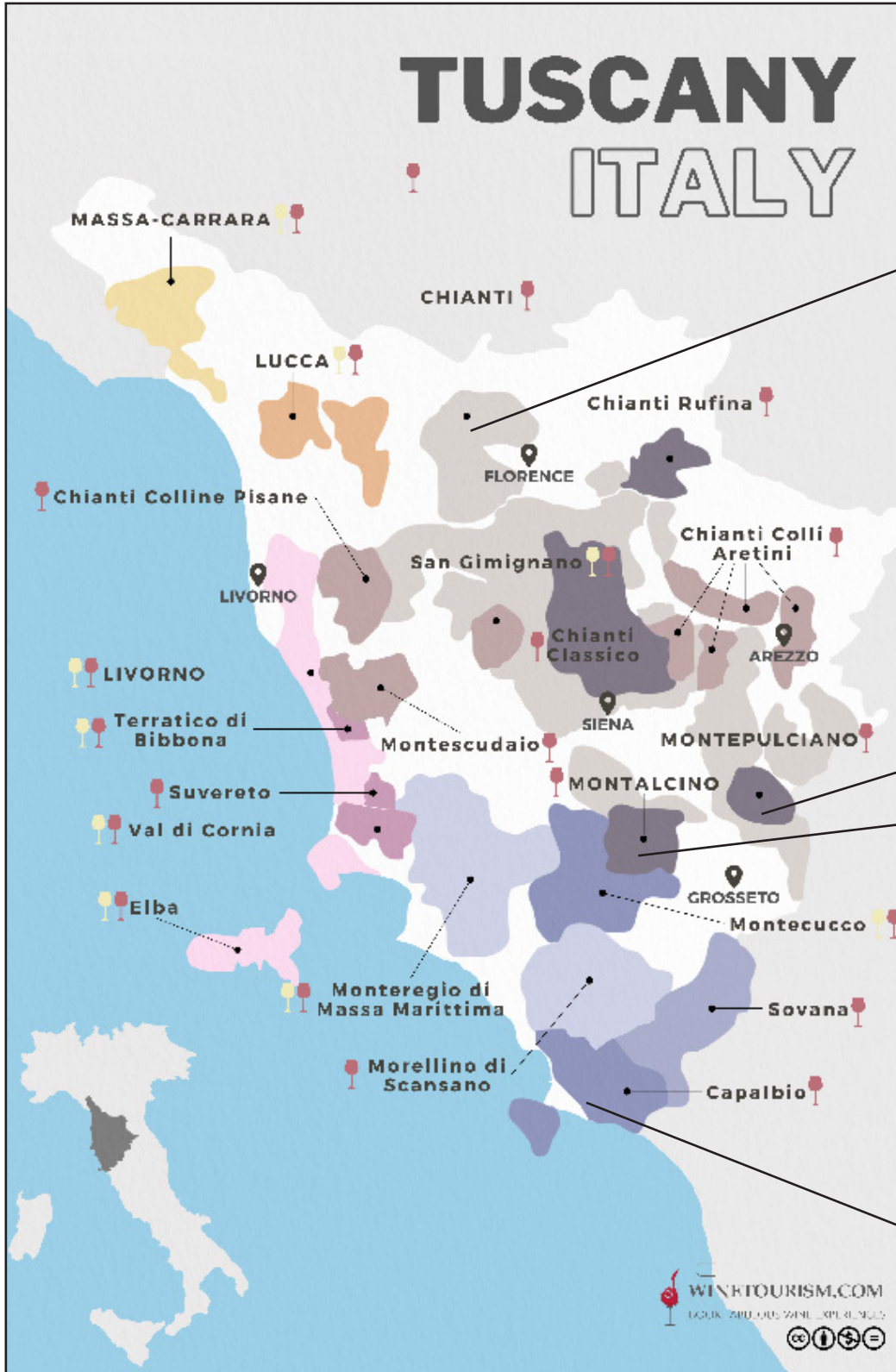

Bertinga winery is located on an exceptional hillside site in the area Gaiole in Chianti. Founded in 2015, it has already an established pedigree in the wine world. Bertinga is one of the best known vineyards in the area; it was owned by Castello di Ama for many years and yielded wines of wonderful finesse and power, as well as drinkability and longevity. Crafting small quantities of terroir driven single parcel/single vineyard wines, Bertinga uses 100% estate grown and organically farmed fruit out its 16.4 hectare planted to Sangiovese and Merlot, both varietals having played the leading role in making the area famous. The picture is complemented by a world class team led by the director Luca Vitiello, the production manager Elisa Ascani and the consulting oenologist Stephan Derenoncourt. To secure an enduring place in the history of Tuscan winemaking is Bertinga's long term aspiration and the goal to share with all partners worldwide.

Tenuta di Bibbiano is located in the municipality of Castellina in Chianti, in the UGA (Additional Geographic Unit) of Castellina, on the west border of the Chianti Classico appellation, close to the castle of Monteriggioni. Its territory represents one of the most romantic and iconic landscapes of Tuscany, a combination of soft hills of reaching 200-300 meters, separated by small valleys, with vineyards and olive groves fragmented by open fields of grain and small woods.

Today the estate extends over more 200 hectares of land with 37 hectares of vineyards, all certified organic and majority Sangiovese. There is also a small quantity of indigenous grapes grown, like Canaiolo, Malvasia Nera, and Colorino as well as some white vines of Trebbiano and Malvasia Bianca del Chianti. The vineyards are located on the two slopes of Bibbiano's hill, two different terroirs for exposition, microclimate and soil: Capannino, looking to south-west, soil with clay and limestone-schistose rock and planted with the Capannino monoclon of Sangiovese Grosso; Montornello looking to north-east, soil with calcareous-clay and round stones plus some chalk and planted with Sangiovese del Chianti. These are the two 'souls' of Bibbiano.

FRATTORIA MONTELLORI

Fattoria Montellori is located in Fucecchio, a small town in the western part of the province of Florence. Montellori has played an active part in the history of Tuscan wine. The largest vineyards of the Montellori estates, are 12 and 16 hectares respectively, and are located on deep soil of limestone clay loam at 150-200 m above sea level in the township of Cerreto Guidi. This part of Tuscany has long been an area for red wine, and in fact remains part of the territory in which Chianti can officially be produced. The philosophy behind the wines is simple: “work at our best in the vineyard to avoid intervention in the cellar”. Montellori still believes in the production and promotion of very well made Chianti DOCG, the same they try to produce every single day.

Cerbaia is a family-owned company that produces wines from some of Montalcino's finest vineyards, with their Brunello being a true representation of a unique and distinct area. The company was started in 1978 by agronomist Fabio Pellegrini, who saw the potential of his land to produce wines of exceptional finesse and complexity. The Cerbaia company has 12 hectares of land, with 4.5 hectares of Brunello grapes located on the hill of Montosoli, one of the most favorable terroirs for Sangiovese in Montalcino. Elena, Fabio's daughter, left her career in finance in 2014 to join the family business and carry on her father's philosophy of making wine with minimal intervention and sustainable practices in their vineyards and products. Today, Cerbaia produces 18,000 bottles of Brunello per year, with their wines being a unique combination of a highly suited land, a traditional winemaking philosophy, and the energy of a young winemaker. The wines that emerge from Cerbaia's vineyards truly represent the authentic terroir of Montalcino.

FANTI

The Fanti Family has been producing wine and extra virgin olive oil in Tuscany for nearly 200 years. In the 1970s, current owner Filippo first took over the Estate, marking a major turning point in its history. After redesigning and replanting across its 300 hectare property, an innovation-meets-tradition winemaking technique has resulted in extremely high-quality grape growing, all while avoiding any non-organic fertilizers. Eighty percent of the plantings in the vineyards are Sangiovese or Sangiovese Grosso, a focus that reinforces the family's commitment to the quality wine of the region and which is reflected in Fanti's highly rated Brunelli. Filippo's daughter Elisa joined the team in 2007 and has since been instrumental in reinforcing their position in the international market.

When Filippo decided to reconfigure their 300 hectare property, he allocated 50 hectares to be grape vines, just half that of the olive grove. He apportioned other plots of the property to crops and woodlands in a layout that was designed to nurture the vineyards. With soil that is laden with limestone and clay, optimal daytime sun exposure and a nighttime thermal drop, the viticulture is carefully orchestrated to mirror the flavors and aromas of both the grape and the territory. The winery itself is partially built into a hill to reduce visual impact and protect the scenery. Inside the winery, Filippo himself has carefully selected everything, from the sorting table, stainless steel vats and pumpover system to a very high standard of barrel selection. As a result, Fanti continues to produce hallmark Southern Montalcino wines with the help of their surrounding terroir and passion for making approachable wines for new wine makers and seasoned pros alike.

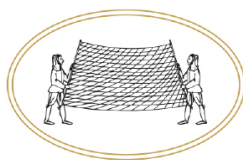

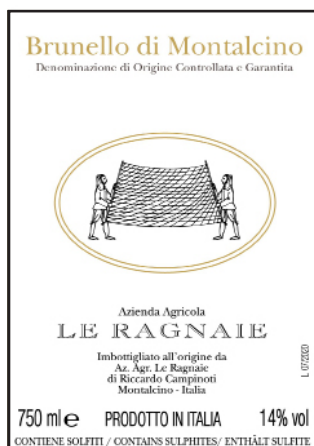

Le Ragnaie is known for its elegant, terroir-driven wines that stand out in this Tuscan powerhouse category. The owner and winemaker, Riccardo Campinoti, acquired the property in 2002 and now farms 15.5 ha. Making complex, traditional wines from Sangiovese Grosso, Riccardo's wines exhibit elegance and finesse by farming some of the highest-altitude vineyards in Montalcino. All four Brunello wines are fermented in concrete without selected yeast followed by a long maceration of up to 90 days and three years in large Slavonian oak botti. All wines are bottled unfiltered and certified organic in the vineyards and cellar.

PEPI LIGNANA

In 1817, Grand Duke Leopold of Tuscany commissioned an updated land survey (cadaster) of the Maremma, the coastal area of southwestern Tuscany with its center at Grosseto on the Mediterranean and stretching into the wild forests and backwaters of the interior. Known as the Leopoldin Cadastre, it already showed vast vineyards planted on the property owned today by the family of Pepi Lignana, known as Fattoria Il Casalone. The Lignana family has been in possession of the property and tending its vines since 1960. The estate consists of about 300 hectares. Today, 14 hectares on the farm are dedicated to high-quality wine production, of which six hectares are planted to white grapes. The proximity to the sea and the presence of hills protecting the northeastern side of the territory ensures mild winter temperatures and dry summers tempered by sea breezes. In advance of harvest, nights are cool and the significant temperature divergence guarantees optimum conditions for the enrichment of the grapes, particularly of aromatic substances.

SALCHETO

Salco means “willow tree” in the ancient Tuscan language, an important plant for wine territories throughout history as its branches were used to bind the vines. Salcheto is the name of the stream, which springs at the foot of the town of Montepulciano and winds through a valley where willows abounded. This stream is the boundary of the Salcheto organic and biodynamic estate, rooted in the historic district of Vino Nobile, in the southeast of the Siena province of Tuscany. The willow tree, a species that we continue to replant at the winery, also contributes to the winery’s energy independence, is today prominently represented in our logo as part of our commitment to environmental sustainability.

As quite possible the most eco-sustainable winery in the world, the Salcheto winery produces wine leaving zero (negative!) carbon footprint. Since 2011, Salcheto has relied on full energy independence, becoming, probably, the first “Off Grid” winery, in the sense of being completely disconnected from traditional power-distribution network. Ultimately, the goal is to work in an environmentally responsible manner to create the greatest expression of quality and authenticity in their wines. With this in mind, Salcheto hopes to bring romance and passion to the science of fine winemaking, blending time-honored tradition with modern technology. It is a life challenge that they take very seriously in making high quality, eco-sustainable Tuscan wines.

Bere, which means “to drink” in Italian, has long been our favorite little Super Tuscan blend and begs just that, to be drunk and enjoyed easily thanks to its rich, crushed berry fruit, earthy backbone and smooth, fresh finish. An inviting blend of Sangiovese with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, aged in used French-oak barrels, it is made from the vineyards of Tenuta Ladronaia, a property located in the craggy hills of the Upper Maremma, a wild and rustic land known for cowboys and outlaws. In fact, “Ladronaia” comes from the Italian word for “thief,” and still today, the villa of the property still hides the cavern and tunnel used for centuries by pirates as a hideout and place to stash their loot. Since the 1900s, the Tenuta has been used as a winery and farm.

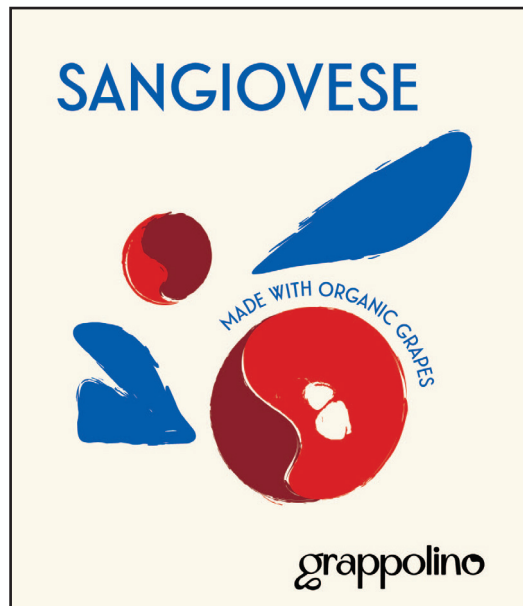
