## MEURSAULT

### LES NARVAUX

This plot is located at the top of the hillside, above the Meursault Premier Cru Genevrières, on clay-limestone soil and a rocky subsoil (very hard white rock), with numerous faults that allow the roots of the vine to circulate in the middle of these white limestones.

The southern exposure of the plot, combined with a regular slope of 20%, allows a very good ventilation of the harvest, which has the effect of obtaining a ripe and still very healthy harvest. We often find candied orange (or other citrus) aromas on the nose and palate.

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**Exhibition:** South at an altitude of 300 metres

**Area:** 0.79 hectare

**Grape variety:** Chardonnay

**Waist:** Pruning the vines in cordon de Royat and simple Guyot

**Guard:** To be drunk generally between 3 and 10 years after bottling.

**Tasting:** Notes of ripe fruit (peach, apricot) and minerality. It goes well with foie gras, white meats and cheese (especially Mont d'Or). The characteristics of this wine are similar to the character of the Meursault 1er Cru Genevrières but with more minerality.

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
