The plot, located at the bottom of the hillside on clay soils and a gravel subsoil, is located at an altitude of about 220 metres.

The major interest of this plot is that it was partly planted in the 1930s for an area of more than one hectare. This allows for a regularity of character (very Meursault: fine and fat without opulence) and above all similar yields from one year to the next whatever the climatic conditions.

The rich and deep soil offers the vines good conditions to flourish.

Exhibition: South / Southeast

Area: 1.32 hectares

Grape variety: Chardonnay

Waist: Pruning the vines in cordon de Royat and simple Guyot

Guard: To be drunk generally between 3 and 8 years after bottling.

Tasting: Hazelnut, velvety, ripeness, freshness. To be served as an aperitif, it also goes very well with fine starters and cheeses.
