SERVE WITH SIMPLE, FRENCH CUISINE FOR TRADITION OR ROASTED FRESHWATER FISH FROM PONDS OR RIVERS FOR SOMETHING NEW. SHOWS EXCEPTIONALLY WELL WITH QUAIL AND SOFT, RIPENED CHEESE.
