SABLETTES IS A SECOND LABEL OF SAUTERNES FROM CHATEAU DOISY VEDRINES IN BARSAC, A COMMUNE THAT IS SAID TO HAVE "NOBLE SOILS." THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE THE SOIL, THE CLIMATE AND THE VINES IS COMPLICITE IN ITS ABILITY TO GIVE BOTRYTIS AN OPPORTUNITY TO WORK ITS MAGIC. ONCE READY, GRAPES ARE HAND HARVESTED AND SORTED UP TO 9 TIMES OVER THE COURSE OF 6-8 WEEKS.



This sauternes features nose of citrus, marmalade, honey and ripe pineapple with a hint of white peppercorn. Sweet on the tip of the tongue with refreshing acidity yielding to an elegant finish.
