

Vineyard Notes:

Dunbar Ranch is located in the heart of Sonoma Valley just north of Glen Ellen. Known only to local farmers as the Glen Ellen moguls, this vineyard site sits atop some of the most complex soil series I have seen in the valley. Similar to the rocky fields of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, round river rocks and sandy loam give way to deeply rooted vines which show incredible minerality, depth, refinement and concentration. The 2 acres of vines we purchase fruit comes from a portion planted intentionally as a field blend: Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Carignan, and Alicante Bouschet. We are incredibly lucky to use fruit from such an unknown vineyard source and fortunate to produce an iconic rendition of a classic Sonoma Valley wine.

Farming: Organic

Soils: Tuscan Cobbly

Vinification:

30% Whole Cluster. Fermented with ambient yeast in 500L puncheon barrels. Pressed at dryness to neutral french oak. Spontaneous malolactic fermentation.

Chemistry: Brix @ Harvest 21.2 pH 3.32 TA 6.25 Alc. 12.1 FSO2: 22ppm
