

# GEN5 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Description:** We strive for a friendly Cabernet Sauvignon, with juicy red and black fruit flavors that is well-balanced and textured and soft on the palate.

**Label Notes:** For five generations our family has lived and worked our land in Lodi, California, always striving to leave the land in a better state for the next generation.

**Vineyards:** Estate vineyards in Lodi, California

**Climate:** Classic Mediterranean. Lodi takes advantage of the gap between the northern and southern coastal ranges surrounding the San Francisco Bay. As the day's temperature rises, cool breezes drift in from the Delta, keeping the nights cool which is ideal for the development of complexity in finished wines.

**Soils:** Well-drained rich mineral soils, sandy to clay loam.

**Varietals:** 94% Cabernet Sauvignon; 2% Petite Verdot; 2% Petit Sirah; 1% Teroldego.

**Average Age of Vines:** 27 years

**Sustainably Farmed:** 100%; Lodi Rules

**Sorting:** Vineyard sorting

**Winemaking:** Grapes are fermented 12 days at 84F. Wine undergoes extended maceration on skins up to 30 days to maximize varietal expression.

**Malolactic Fermentation:** 100%

**Aging:** 8 months with French (80%) and American (20%) oak.

**Alcohol:** 14.2%

**Residual Sugar:** 3.7 g/L

**Acidity:** pH of 3.67; TA of 6.4 g/L
