REGION/VINEYARDS

Castilla is a Spanish geographical indication for Vino de la Tierra wines located in the region of Castilla-La Mancha. Here the wines are made to be enjoyed young, defined by their fruity and easy drinking characteristics. Soils offer a combination of clay, chalk, and limestone all sharing great drainage characteristics.

100% Estate grown and sustainably farmed.

PROCESS

After thorough grape selection and sorting in the winery, fermentation takes place naturally in temperature controlled vessels with a minimal use of sulfur. The wine spends 8 months in neutral oak barrels, which builds flavor and textural complexity while preserving the purity of the fruit.

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby color with aromas of raspberry, red cherry and licorice. Medium-bodied with finely structured tannins that carry the wine through a lengthy finish on the palate.

THE WINERY & FAMILY

The winery is located in Chinchilla de Montearagon in Albacete, La Mancha, an area perfectly situated for growing high quality fruit due to the high-elevated plateau on which the vineyards sit. Very cold winters (one of the coldest areas in Spain) and very hot, dry summers help to stress the vines and produce this high quality fruit.



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
