PRODUCTION ZONE: All the Estates's vineyards in Bibbiano, Castellina in Chianti.

SOIL TYPE: Clay lime and mixed stratified limestone rock.

EXPOSURE: South-West and North-East

HARVEST PERIOD: end of October.
COMPOSITION: 100% Sangiovese

FERMENTATION AND AGEING: Three years in small casks made of

various types of wood.

SUGAR RESIDUE: 130 g/l

BOTTLE SIZES: 0.375 L

COLOR: Delicate amber-tinged red.

AROMAS: Dried fruit, ethereal of acacia honey.

TASTE: Sweetness of fruit balanced by persistent sapidity.
